Book Rental / Purchase Scheme

Every child needs access to school books and a school book rental schemes provide a viable solution.

St Laurence's National school tonight launch our Book rental / purchase scheme for September 2015. Inclusion in the scheme is completely voluntary and at parents discretion.

What is a school book rental scheme and why set one up?

Our school book rental scheme means that the school will purchase all textbooks and workbooks for those who avail of the scheme. We can facilitate you with the following options:

1. Rental (all textbooks) and Purchase (all workbooks)
2. Purchase (all textbooks and workbooks)
3. Rental only (textbooks)
4. Rental (textbooks) and purchase (workbooks) as required

How will the scheme work?

- Book lists will be confirmed by the end of April each year.
- Book lists will be issued to parents in May. This will include purchase prices and rental prices. Parents / guardians can choose to opt in or out of the scheme.
- Fees will be collected during the month of May for those participating.
- All books under this scheme will be available for collection during the third week in June. (Please note, rented books supplied under the scheme may be new or used).

What are the benefits of the scheme?

- Significant savings to parents
- Books will be available in the schools
- Parents no longer have to go through the hassle of purchasing books
- Curriculum Change – The School book rental scheme will absorb the cost of book changes in curriculum.
